Job Description:

E3R Inc is seeking candidates to fill an IT Specialist position at its Mission Valley, San Diego location. This person will start the build out a 25 seat SIPRNet interior secure space at the E3RInc facility in Mission Valley. This person will determine the required bill of materials to build out the interior of the secure facility, using guidance and inputs from DSCA and NMCI. This person will act as the liaison between the E3RInc Program Manager and NMCI and SDREN, the network providers. Following design guidelines, this individual will provide E3R leadership with analysis of alternatives and recommendations for acquisition as build continues through completion.

After facility build-out is complete, this specialist will be responsible for set up of the classified network, seats and terminals provided in order to create the network Point of Presence (PoP). This person will assist the E3RInc project manager in setting up and maintaining the facility integrated master schedule (IMS) and major milestones. This IT specialist will assist the facility ISSM during the RMF controls testing, system validation and authorization processes.

Functional Description:

- Using guidance from E3R Inc senior management, DSCA and NMCI, develop the plan for a 25seat secure network facility
- Interface with NMCI and DSCA network providers to gather Bill of Materials and quotes
- Work with E3R Inc project manager to provide inputs to the facility IMS and provide status to the IMS project baseline.
- Provide status updates to the contract PM and PMW 770 senior leadership
- Initiate the steps necessary to open the RMF authorization process with DCSA
- Using guidance provided, provide inputs to the facility ISSM for the documents required to operate and maintain the facility once it goes on-line.
- Act as ADMIN for the network and user community once the facility opens up
- Provide Continuous Monitoring services as specified by DSCA and NMCI
- This IT specialist reports to the E3RInc program manager
