Job Description: E3R is seeking qualified candidates to fill a **Logistician II** position. Level II logisticians support lifecycle logistics, supply support, and sustainment activities for **NAVWAR** programs. This position assists senior logisticians in maintaining configuration, provisioning, and sustainment documentation in accordance with Navy and NAVWAR Integrated Logistics Support (ILS) policies. The role contributes directly to fleet modernization and readiness by ensuring accurate logistics data, documentation, and reporting across all phases of system lifecycle management. The logistician works in a dynamic, team-oriented environment supporting logistics planning, certification, and configuration tracking. Responsibilities include preparing and updating logistics documentation, maintaining provisioning and sparing data, and coordinating inputs for certifications, reviews, and data calls that support system fielding and sustainment objectives.

Program: This effort supports **PEO C4I PMW/A 170** in providing end-to-end lifecycle logistics, training, installation, and configuration management support to Navy communications and positioning, navigation, and timing (PNT) systems. The program's mission is to deliver advanced, resilient, and adaptive C4I capabilities that ensure maritime operational dominance across all domains. The contractor team will integrate closely with government leads, Fleet Readiness Directorates (FRDs), Platform and Portfolio Program Offices, and industry partners to plan, execute, and sustain complex modernization and fielding initiatives. Work includes developing and maintaining integrated logistics products, configuration baselines, and training documentation; coordinating and tracking shipboard and shore installations; ensuring compliance with NAVWAR and NAVSEA standards; and producing required reports and deliverables in accordance with contract requirements. Personnel will operate in a collaborative environment supporting system readiness, fielding synchronization, and lifecycle sustainment objectives in alignment with PEO C4I's overarching mission to deliver interoperable, secure, and modern warfighting systems to the Fleet.

Position Duties:

- Assist in developing and updating logistics products such as LCSPs, ILS Certifications, and provisioning documentation.
- Maintain accurate logistics and configuration data in Navy databases (e.g., CDMD-OA, MBPS, SPIDER, NDE).
- Support supply chain and provisioning analysis, including Readiness Based Sparing (RBS) and DMSMS tracking.
- Participate in Integrated Product Teams (IPTs), working groups, and program data calls.
- Prepare logistics reports, schedules, and briefing materials for government review.
- Track logistics actions, deliverables, and certifications to ensure compliance with NAVWAR policies.



Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in logistics, business, managerial, or technical disciplines.
- 3-6 years DoW logistics experience supporting acquisition or sustainment.
- Demonstrated expertise with Navy logistics systems desired (e.g., PARTS, MBPS, SPIDER, NDE).
- Ability to work collaboratively across multi-discipline technical teams, including engineering, logistics, installation, and configuration management.
